# 1st Day of School (1st through 5th grades): Tuesday, August 15th

- 1st bell rings at 8:55 a.m.
- Tardy bell rings at 9:00 a.m.
- Last bell rings at 3:30 p.m. for dismissal

#### Diagnostic Testing (1st through 5th grades): Friday, August 25th and Monday, August 28th

\*There is NO school these days. These days will be for diagnostic reading testing. When the school year begins, your child's teacher will reach out to you to sign up for a time to bring your child. These typically only take about 20-30 minutes and we expect you to sit and wait for your child.

Kindergarten: Your diagnostic testing will take place with the KEEP assessment. (Information below!)

#### KINDERGARTEN Students: August 15th - 18th

- Kinder will come to school from 9:00 12:00 p.m.
- NO lunch will be served.
- NO buses will run. (Allowing your child to ride the AM bus this week would be okay.)
- Your child's teacher will schedule a time with you to bring your child back one of these afternoons for the state KEEP assessment test and the district literacy diagnostic test. These usually take about 20-30 minutes and we expect you to sit and wait for your child.

#### SEPs:

- The district is making some changes to SEPs beginning next school year. We will only be holding two official SEPs for the school year.
- The first SEPs will be <u>September 20th and 21st between 4:00 7:00 p.m</u>. We will have regular school days from 9:00 3:30 p.m. on these days.
- The second SEPs is <u>January 16-19, 2024</u>. These days will be early-out where students are dismissed at 12:00 noon and SEPs will be scheduled in the afternoons.
- As we get closer to these times, teachers will schedule meeting times with you and your child.
