## Question and Answer

### 1. How do I “Pass Off” a book?

- a. You will work with your teacher to pass a book off. Each teacher may have a different way of doing this. You or your teacher will let Mrs. Newby know.

### 2. Can I listen to these books instead of reading them?

- a. YES! We want you to work on being able to read these levels of books BUT if you are happier listening to them that also counts! Try following along with the book while you listen.
- b. It also counts if you read them in class!

### 3. How do I get the book? What if the book isn't available?

- a. The library has all books available but only a few at a time. Move on to another book and put your name on the waitlist for the book to be checked out. OR you may check these books out at the Hurricane Library.

### 4. Why did you pick these particular books? Can I use a different one?

- a. These books are picked based on your grade level, the content and curriculum you are learning in your grade, and have been some of the Battle of the Books Challenge across the nation! IF you or your parents feel uncomfortable with a certain book, you may talk with your teacher and pick a different book.

### 5. Who do I ask if I have more questions?

- a. Your teacher, Mrs. Newby (reading interventionist), or Mrs. Wheeler (librarian)
